

BLACK

Black tea is thought to have been developed during the Ming Dynasty (1368 - 1644). It is the most oxidised of all the tea types and generally has a stronger flavour than other teas. We stock black teas from China, India & Sri Lanka. Most black tea is made from fully oxidised green tea leaves.

ENGLISH BREAKFAST (not displayed)

Made from a blend of high quality Assam teas, our English Breakfast has a full malty flavour and a rich dark colour.

ASSAM BOP (not displayed)

Single Estate Broken Orange Pekoe Assam is a great alternative to standard English Breakfast tea. It has a rich, sweet and malty flavour.

CEYLON ORANGE PEKOE (not displayed)

A very high grade black tea from Sri Lanka. When brewed it gives a light infusion and with extra steeping time can take milk. It has a rich smooth flavour.

BLUE LADY – FLAVOURED BLACK TEA

Blue Lady is flavoured with grapefruit and pomegranate. It is a great alternative to Earl Grey.

EARL GREY (not displayed)

Our Earl Gray is made of a base high grade Chinese black tea and scented with a natural bergamot oil producing a traditional classic of outstanding quality.

DARJEELING 2ND FLUSH BOP (not displayed)

Darjeeling is known as the champagne of teas and is known for its muscatel flavour. This broken leaf tea version is perfect for everyday drinking and infuses strongly enough to take milk.

MANX FAIRY BRIDGE (not displayed)

A carefully selected, locally packed blend of African and Indian teas produce a pure bright tea, full of flavour, a tasty refreshing cup of tea.

LAPSANG SOUCHONG

A black tea originally from the Wuyi region of the Chinese province of Fujian. It is sometimes referred to as smoked tea. Lapsang is distinct from all other types of tea because lapsang leaves are traditionally smoke-dried over pinewood fires which produces the distinctive smoky flavour. Our Lapsang is hand processed using the best tea leaves and wood for smoking.

VIOLET BLACK

Aromatic Chinese black tea flavoured with violet and blended with violet blossoms. Violet Tea has a beautiful appearance and a delicate flavour that goes very well with chocolate.

CHAI-LICIOUS MASALA CHAI TEA

Leela's Kitchen award winning masala chai. This small batch signature blend is a combination of 100% single estate Assam tea leaves, blended with exotic fresh Indian spices including cardamom, cinnamon, cloves & Malabar black peppercorns, giving this tea a strong and full bodied character with a slightly malty & exotic flavour.

RUSSIAN CARAVAN

With its typical aroma this strong Russian blend will remind you of times past when teas were still transported by camel caravans from the land of origin to Russia & Europe. Best served black but can be taken with milk or a slice of lemon.

WHITE

White tea is famous for its mellow, delicate flavour and its smooth mouth feel. Made from young buds and leaves harvested in early spring, white tea is the least processed of all teas and undergoes very little oxidation.

MOONLIGHT WHITE

Moonlight White is a superb example of Chinese white tea from Yunnan Province. It has a smooth creamy texture and a clean, refreshing and slightly fruity flavour.

GIN & TONIC TEA

A white tea combined with apple pieces, lemon peel & pink rose petals. Wonderfully delicate and floral.

GREEN

Green tea has a history that stretches back thousands of years. Today there is an almost unfathomable variety, ranging widely in shape and flavour. Green tea is kept green by halting the oxidation process very early on, and tends to be light and sweet or fresh and grassy – however some exhibit rich, umami (savoury) flavours.

CHERRY SENCHA

A delicious blend of Japanese Sencha green tea, flavoured with natural cherry. Sencha is Japan's most popular green tea, this delightful drink is a true celebration of what makes Japan so unique.

ORGANIC SENCHA

We import this Japanese Sencha ourselves. It is a spring harvest tea with a pleasing balance of sweetness and astringency, along with a slight vegetal taste. Grown and harvested in the Makinohara district of Shizuoka Prefecture, one of the world's premiere tea growing regions.

YUNAN GREEN – CHINESE GREEN TEA

Yunan tea is a great tasting accessible green tea that is easy to prepare. It is very forgiving of hot water, making it a perfect standard green tea.

GUARDIAN ANGEL OOLONG
